Bids shall be made on the items as listed in the "Schedule of Proposal". Prices quoted shall be guaranteed for a period of ninety (90) days after the date of the proposal.

Bids shall be submitted on forms to be provided by Community High School 99 and completed in full. The sealed envelope containing your bid should be plainly marked: "**Sealed Bid – English Novel Bid**". The Board of Education reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive minor informalities in any bid, or to make award in the best interest of Community High School District 99.

Errors and Omissions:

All bids shall be submitted with each space properly completed. The special attention of Bidders is directed to the policy that no claim for relief because of errors or omissions in bidding will be considered and Bidders will be held strictly to the bids as submitted.

All bidders must satisfy themselves as to the intent of these specifications. Once the successful bidder has been selected and approved, the District will issue separate Purchases Orders for each classroom where the books will be used. We anticipate issuing approximately sixty-four (64) individual Purchase Orders. Twenty-seven (27) are expected to be for deliveries to the North Campus and thirty-seven (37) are expected to be for deliveries to the South Campus. These counts may vary slightly.

Each Purchase Order will indicate school delivery address, teacher name and classroom number. Shipments are to be delivered in separate packaging based on each Purchase Order. Individual Purchase Order materials may not be combined with materials from another Purchase Order even if it is being shipped to the same high school and same teacher as classroom locations may be different.

School address, teacher name and classroom number must be clearly visible on each address label, on every box, and must be able to be seen by our receiving clerks without their having to open each box.
